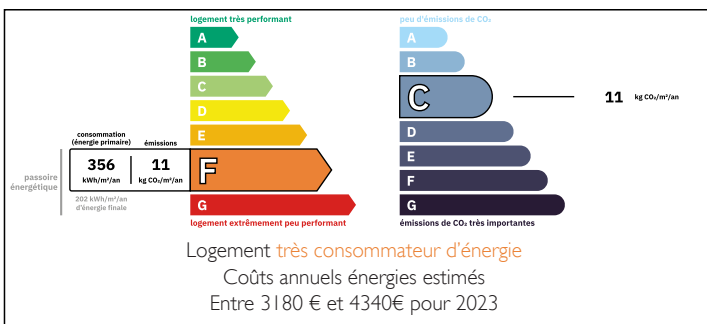

The ground floor features two living rooms: one cozy with a wood-burning stove, the other with stone walls and a bay window to the garden and pool. On this floor you'll find also an en-suite bedroom. The kitchen with baywindows overlooking the terrace, creates a bright and welcoming living area.

Upstairs are three comfortable bedrooms, including two with en-suite bathrooms and toilets, as well as a utility room. An independent studio remains to be designed according to your desires.
