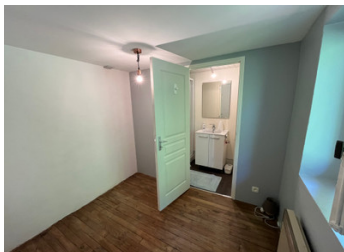
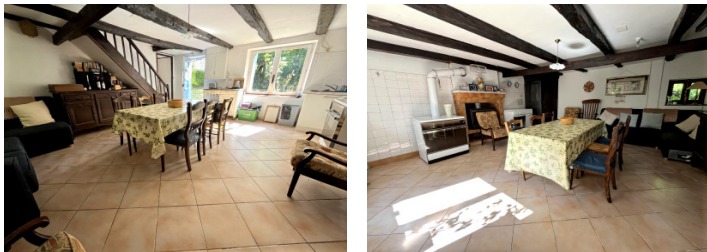

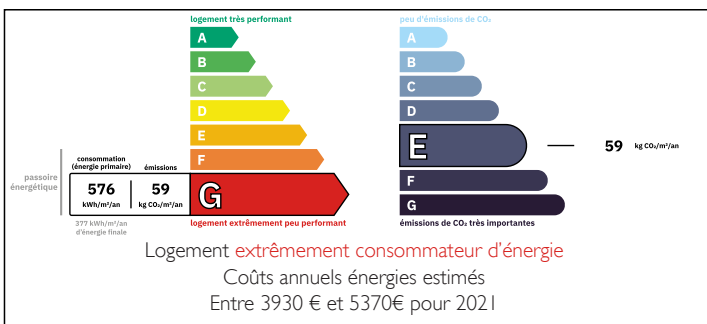

DESCRIPTION

The entrance to the house leads directly into the open plan living, dining and kitchen area (24m²) with wood burner. To the right of the open plan room is a utility room (8m²) and a shower room with WC. Stairs from the living room lead up to first floor which has two bedrooms (10m² and 12m²), a small room that could easily be made into an office (6m²) and a shower room with WC.

Up in the loft is the third bedroom (7m², measured at head height). Attached to the house is a small barn, and then attached to the barn is a small house to renovate.

There is a nice mature garden surrounds the house, and there is a stone BBQ and also a woodstore.

Separate from the house there is also another plot of land (1320m²) with a delightful stream running through it, an ideal space for nature lovers to enjoy.

Within a 15 minute drive from the house there is Lac de Vassiviere with beaches, water sports, cafes and restaurants. There is also the market towns of Bourgneuf and Eymoutiers with shops, supermarkets, cinemas, and restaurants. Regular weekly markets offer local produce for sale.

The area is rich with wildlife and with very little light pollution, it is one of the best areas in Europe for stargazing. It is ideal for water sports, and other outdoor pursuits like cycling and hiking The house is about a one hour drive from Limoges...
