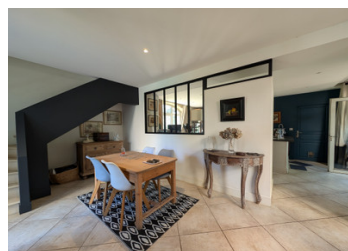
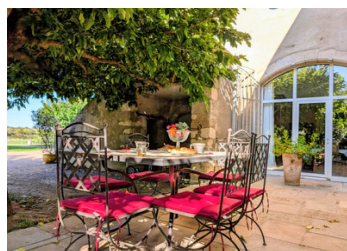

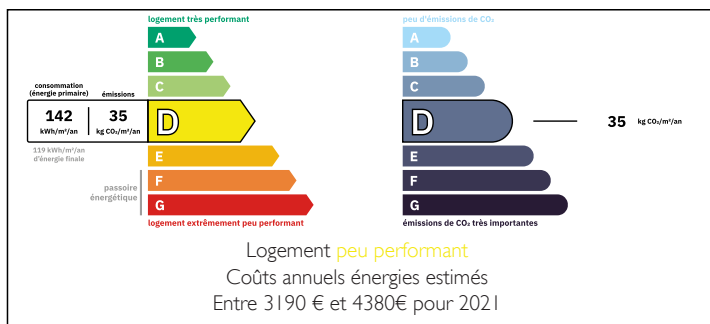

We pass through the beautiful wrought iron entrance gate and walk along one of the outbuildings, a superb stone structure adorned with ivy, setting the tone for what is to come!

Then we discover the manor house, an imposing and elegant building spread over two floors with a side wing. Opposite it are the meadows, stables and other outbuildings! A beautiful estate!

We now enter the house, built in 1803, which has undergone a superb renovation, thanks to Mr Cabrol, a renowned architect who has enhanced all the architectural features and given this residence modernity and comfort.

The large hall leads to a 33m² office, which could easily be converted into a ground floor bedroom if required, followed by a bathroom and WC. We follow the corridor that leads us to the central living room and dining room, which opens onto two terraces on either side, allowing you to enjoy the shade and the sun on the pool side. Needless to say, these rooms are beautifully lit with their custom-made arched windows! Everything is spacious, functional and magnificent, from the floors to the fireplace.

In the extension, there is a new dining area, a 23m² semi-open kitchen, a boiler room and a laundry room.

The upper floor and its private sleeping area offer five bedrooms, including a magnificent 34m² en suite, two with en suite bathrooms, and two others with a shared bathroom.
