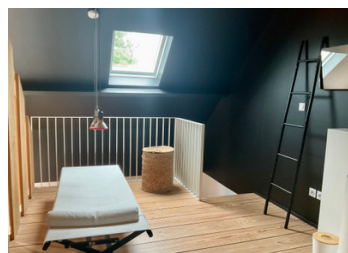
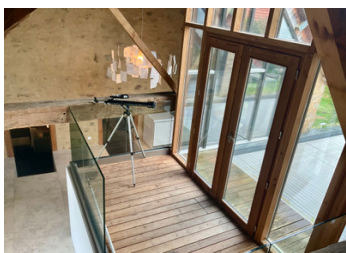


UNDER OFFER Stunning country property used as 10-person 4 deluxe rental retreat plus second house, with pool

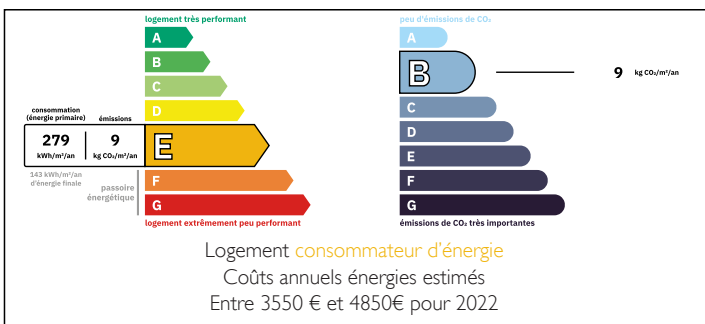

DESCRIPTION

Nestled in a tranquil hamlet, this property is a hidden gem. There are two houses: the main house which is currently used as a deluxe 10-person rental property, and a separate small house to the rear to be fully renovated. This would be ideal on-site owner accommodation, a second rental property, or new owners may choose to live in main house and use the second, once renovated, as a rental gite.

The main house, a fusion of contemporary design and cosy cottage, is accessed via a private and easily maintained, decked terrace with barbecue, seating and an outdoor dining area.

The impressive entrance hall is flooded with light and looks out to the swimming pool at the rear. To the right is a ground floor double bedroom, toilet/utility room, with stairs leading up to a spa area. Here you will find a 4-person jacuzzi and treatment bed with heat lamps.

To the left is the main accommodation. Look out to the back garden area and designer pool from the fitted Bulthaup luxury kitchen. On one wall there is an Aga wood-fired stove which provides warmth, in tandem with the underfloor heating. A door leads to the back garden which in turn leads to a neighbouring traditional detached granite cottage, also part of the sale. This house is in need of complete renovation but affords the possibility of additional rental accommodation.
