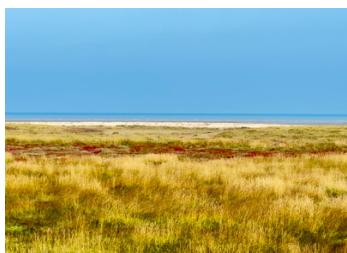
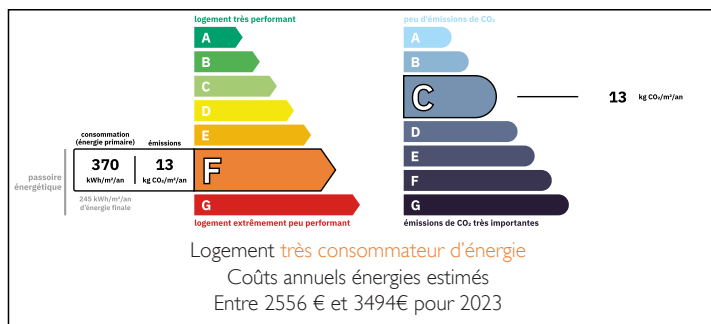


LE MOULIN NEUF – Bay of Mont-Saint-Michel

IN BRIEF

Facing the immensity of Mont St-Michel Bay, the Moulin Neuf stands tall, its stone silhouette immutable and serene.

Built in the 19th century, it was once powered by the coastal winds before being converted into a villa in the 1920s.

Its granite and slate architecture, typical of Brittany, blends into the landscape with quiet nobility.

From its heights, the eye takes in exceptional panoramic views of the sea and Mont-Saint-Michel, a living spectacle where sky and water meet.

Throughout the day, the light constantly changes, gliding over the stone and playing with the reflections of the tides.

Each window becomes a moving picture, an invitation to contemplation.

This rare place, both powerful and soothing, embodies the most authentic and poetic side of Brittany.

DESCRIPTION

Located in Cherrueix, between Saint-Malo and Mont Saint-Michel, this 19th-century windmill is a real gem of Breton heritage. Built on the Duchesse Anne dyke, it enjoys an exceptional location between land and sea, with breathtaking views of the bay's landscapes.

Built on a 1,533 m² plot, it offers 108 m² of living space on three levels, bathed in natural light and opening onto 180° panoramic views of the sea, beach and countryside.

The ground floor features a cosy living room with a wood-burning stove, a separate fitted and equipped kitchen, a bedroom with a shower room, and a contemporary bathroom.

Upstairs, a large bedroom opens onto two terraces, one facing the bay of Mont-Saint-Michel, the other overlooking the private garden and the countryside.

The top floor features a bright bedroom offering spectacular views.

At the rear, a landscaped garden, a true haven of tranquillity, invites contemplation.

A separate garage and a terrace opening onto the garden complete this rare property, ideal for lovers of sea views and places steeped in poetry.
