

# DESCRIPTION

Set in beautiful rolling countryside, this traditional 3-bedroom stone farmhouse is full of authentic charm and renovation potential (see home staged photo nr5) The ground floor opens into a 25 m² kitchen/living area with tiled floor, wood burner, and chimney, plus an electric cooker. The front windows are double-glazed, and there is a separate toilet. A cellar is also located on this level, with the possibility to enlarge the living area.

An original wooden staircase leads to the first floor, where you'll find a shower room, separate toilet, a spacious 17 m² bedroom, and a large 20 m² bedroom with views over the private back garden with peach trees. Behind this room lies a third bedroom, preserved like a time capsule. Between the two main bedrooms, a staircase gives access to the well-insulated attic above the living spaces. Water boiler heated by the woodstove in the kitchen.

Attached to the house are traditional stables and a pigsty, with galvanized guttering in good condition.

The property sits on 2,467 m<sup>2</sup> of private land with fruit trees, a chicken run, a greenhouse, and a large outbuilding including stables, a hangar for parking, and upper-level vehicle access. The yard is already quite private but could easily be made even more secluded.
