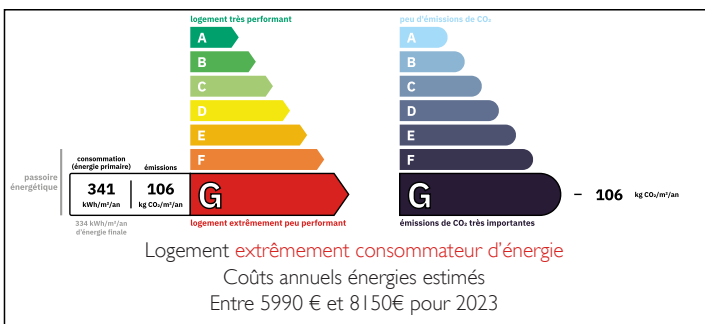
IN BRIEF

Attached to the house are numerous outbuildings offering large volumes and high ceilings, ideal for creating workshops, studios, storage or future living space.

Those are a boiler room, an old wine store, a cellar, a barn, a carport and a former henhouse

From of the outbuildings, you can access the property's attic which could also be converted, offering the possibility to increase the habitable space.

Separate from the main house, you'll find two garages, a well, and an additional storage building.

The 5,700 m² plot includes a small orchard, garden areas, and plenty of space for animals, a large vegetable garden, or a landscaped outdoor living area.
