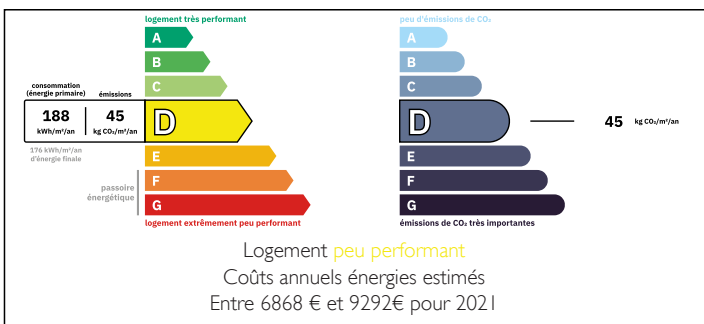

The main house – 300 m²

- Garden level: 1 entrance hall, 1 shower room/WC, 1 small lounge/bedroom, 1 large bright lounge with fireplace, 1 dining room with wood-burning stove, 1 separate fitted kitchen

- First floor: 3 spacious bedrooms, each with 1 fireplace, 2 bathrooms, 1 with WC, and 1 separate WC.

- Attic: 2 bedrooms and 1 bathroom with WC.

The separate gîte – 126 m²

- Ground floor: 1 lounge/dining room with fireplace, 1 fitted kitchen, 1 bathroom and 1 bedroom

- Upstairs: 2 bedrooms, 1 WC and 1 mezzanine

The restored dovecote – 77 m²

- Ground floor: 1 entrance hall, 1 shower room/WC

- First floor: 1 superb bedroom with exceptional traditional roof structure.
