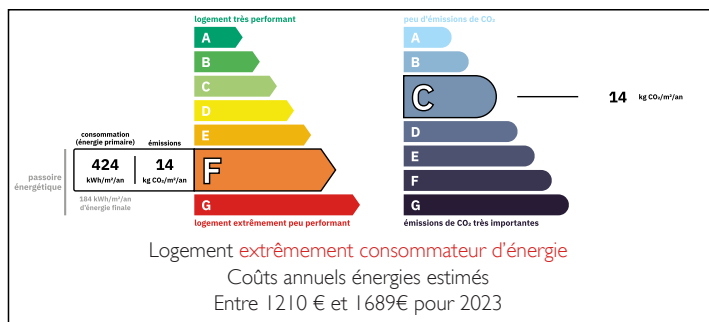

## LOCAL TAXES

**Taxe foncière: 872 EUR**

Built over 7 floors, this 18th century property is located in the area of Notre Dame and includes 6 apartments. The residence is constructed on a plot of 59m<sup>2</sup> located 233m from Cite metro station (L4) and 312 m from Hotel de Ville metro station (L1 & 11). Self-service bike system 'Velib' nearby.

4th arrondissement, Ile de la Cité (Notre Dame) is, along with Ile Saint-Louis, one of the two natural islands in the Seine in Paris with a population of 891 (census 1.1.2016). Considered to be the ancient cradle of the city of Paris, formerly Lutetia, the name "cité" refers to the fortified limits of Paris as they were at the end of Antiquity and which were the urban core of the medieval city. In both London and Paris, the name 'cité' or 'city' bears witness to the...
