DESCRIPTION

The main house comprises, on the ground floor, a fitted kitchen (18.57m²), a generous lounge/dining room (22.58m²), downstairs bedroom (12.11m²), an office (8.1m²), a bathroom (9.42m²) with both bath and shower, and a separate WC. The basement level includes a boiler room (17.95m²), garage, workshop (20.92m²), and a cellar (20.59m²), providing excellent storage and working space.

On the first floor, there is a spacious landing (11.3m²) which leads to three additional bedrooms (19.8m²) (10.35m²) (9.71m²), a shower room with toilet (3.5m²), and a supplementary room (6.12m²) ideal for use as a dressing room or further storage.

Externally, the property boasts two substantial barns, several outbuildings, and a second house requiring renovation, offering great potential for creating a gîte or guest accommodation. A terrace area leads to a renovated summer kitchen (19.88m²), nearby there is a vegetable garden.

This is a rare opportunity to acquire a versatile and character-filled property in a tranquil natural environment, suitable as a family home, smallholding, or tourism project.
