DESCRIPTION

You enter directly into a bright 19 m² room, already double glazed and featuring a charming central fireplace. The windows and entrance door have been fitted, giving you a solid starting point for further renovation. Leading off this main room are two smaller spaces (3.9 m² and 2.7 m²) that would make an ideal kitchen area or practical storage rooms, along with a larger room awaiting complete renovation and ready for your ideas.

A beautiful hand-crafted oak staircase takes you to the first floor, where a generous 24 m² room offers the perfect space for a main bedroom, complete with original oak floorboards and two large double glazed windows that fill the room with natural light. The staircase continues up to the loft of 20m², which could easily be converted into a second bedroom if required.

While the property has no private outdoor space, the delightful village of St Fraimbault more than makes up for it, offering lovely communal gardens, picnic areas and quiet spots to relax by its lake.

Mains water needs to be brought into the house and an electrician will need to separate the electrics that are currently shared with the neighbour. Bedroom and living room have double glazed windows.
