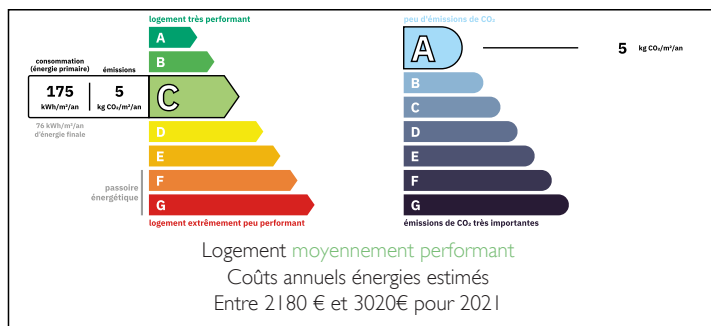

A further living room or downstairs bedroom is ready for renovation with potential for a downstairs shower room. / cloakroom. A garage, a rare asset in the village, completes this level. A traditional wine cave, perfect for storage and ageing, adds to the property's authentic appeal.

On the first floor, a landing leads to a newly renovated bedroom, office, dressing room, and shower room with fitted laundry. There is also an additional room ready to be converted, with the potential to create two further bedrooms and bathrooms.
