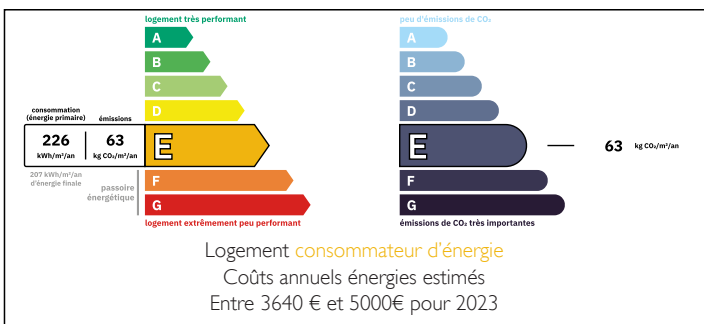
IN BRIEF

The main house features a spacious living room with impressive ceiling height and a fully equipped kitchen. The first floor offers two bedrooms, a study, a shower room and a toilet. The garden level includes a summer kitchen, an additional bedroom with its own shower room, and a laundry room—ideal for hosting guests independently.

The grounds of almost 3000m² also include a partially converted barn, offering a generous 21 m² bedroom with bathroom and toilet. The remaining section serves as a garage, but with further potential for development.

Interior

From the road this property is approached via two separate entrances, one to the front of the main house and the other via the barn. The front door and the french windows both bring you into the impressive living room (approx: 41m²), combining a comfortable seating area with dining area and fitted kitchen, with gorgeous views from the sink across the fields to the river - a lovely accompaniment to the often boring job of doing the washing up. A pretty stone staircase takes you up the the first floor, which consists of an open-plan study (approx: 8m²), two bedrooms (approx: 14m² and 12m²) both with views down to the river, and the larger of which also benefits from a beautiful marble fireplace. Opposite the two bedrooms are the shower room (approx: 4m²) with a shower and basin, and next door a loo (approx: 2m²) and a small store room or dressing room (approx: 3m²). At the end of the corridor is a glazed door leading to a staircase which takes you down into the garden. From the living room is a short passage way to a staircase which takes you down to the lower ground floor which houses the fitted summer kitchen (approx: 18m²), the third bedroom (approx: 11m²), a utility room and second shower (approx: 10m²) housing the washing machine, a dishwasher, a water softener, the separate downstairs loo, the oil-fired central heating boiler, hot water tank and, hidden behind a wall...
