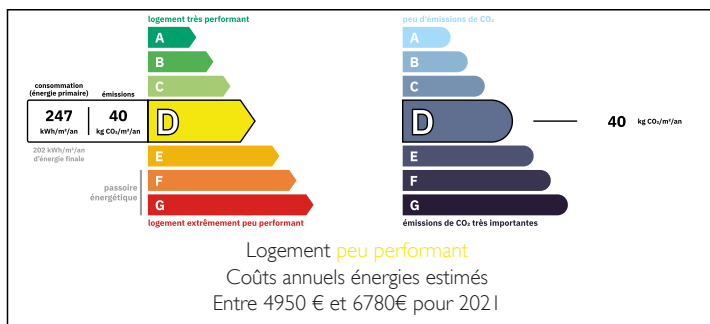
Located in Melrand, in the heart of a peaceful and green environment, this property of approximately 223 m² offers open views over the countryside.

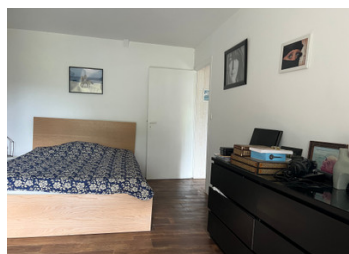
