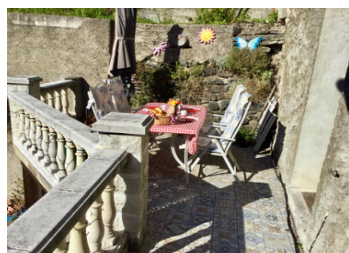

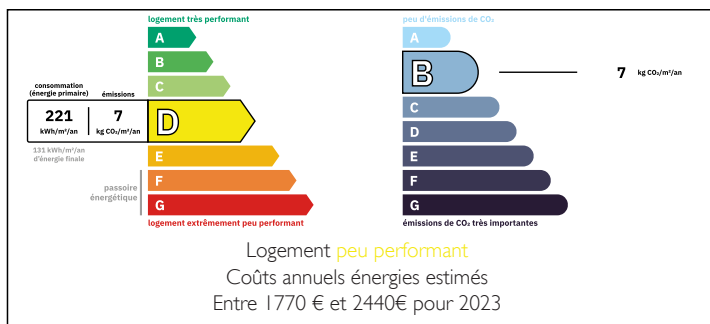

DESCRIPTION

This property boasts one of the finest elevated views over the charming village of Montfort-Sur-Boulzane. Facing due south, the terrace offers al fresco dining while admiring the superb vistas beyond of the year-round beauty of the surrounding foothills of the Pyrenees. The house is situated in a small square, sharing it with only two other properties.

The house offers plenty of space for a family or holiday groups, comprising four double bedrooms and a modern open plan kitchen/lounge/diner with original character features, such as the large Inglenook fireplace with log burner and bread oven. There are two attractive, recently modernised bathrooms, a large landing area that works as a secondary lounge area/quiet space and also a huge ground floor space, originally the stable, useful for storage of ski and other sports equipment and as a workshop which includes a toilet, laundry and utility area.

The house can be sold with all white goods and fully furnished.

Montfort-sur-Boulzane is a beautiful, peaceful village regularly frequented by trades such as bakery and epicerie vans and a mobile hairdresser. The local restaurant and café, a five minute walk from the house, will also be opening a village shop with fresh bread and vegetables. For those looking to integrate into village life and meet its international population, Montfort-sur-Boulzane also holds events such as its three day fête and the sardine festival.
