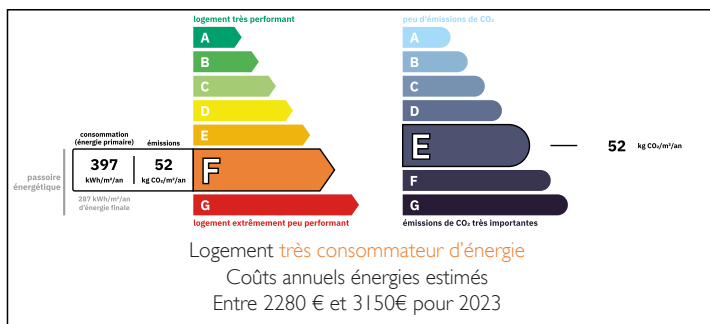

Beautifully situated farmhouse to restore with outbuildings and garage and guesthouse. Beautiful view of the rolling hills from the courtyard. This house is in a rural location, yet the city is close by. Just 3 km away you will find the city of Gueugnon where you can go for everything. There are schools, shops, supermarkets, a weekly market, a factory provides employment. Cinema, bars and restaurants, doctors, pharmacists... Everything is there, close by.

This house has been empty for a while and needs some love and a motivated construction worker to bring everything back in order. The house is immediately habitable but probably no longer meets today's standards. Everything is dated.

There is an entrance hall from which we enter the small kitchen where there is a gas stove. There is city gas here, so cooking and heating is done partial on gas. We also find a back kitchen with a gas stove and sink, and a connection for the washing machine. Here is also the water boiler of 100 liters. From the kitchen there is also access to the separate toilet and the bathroom with shower and sink and a built-in cupboard.

On the other side of the kitchen we step into the living room. A lovely room with stone floor and wooden beamed ceiling. From this room there is a door to the garden. Lots of light in this room through the large glass door and a window on the other side. This room is heated...
