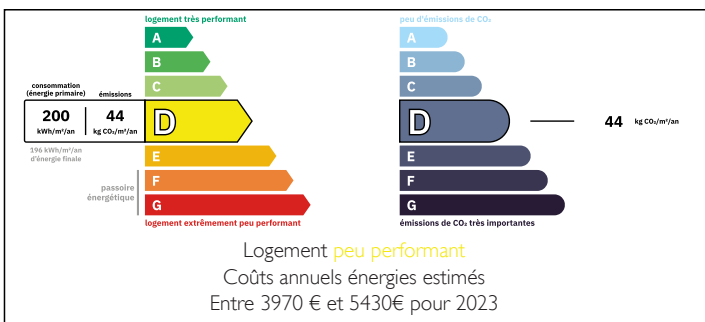


Charming house in a beautiful, quiet location with panoramic views, close to shops! Near Saint-Emilion!

The whole setting evokes a romantic atmosphere typical of the South of France! DESCRIPTION

THE HOUSE – almost entirely single-storey – offers 232 m² of living space, with generous sized rooms!

Ground Floor:

* Entrance – 7 m² – with built-in closet;

Original 18th-century section:

* Living/Dining Room – 35 m² – exposed wooden beams, stone walls, fireplace;

* Kitchen – 16 m²;

* Bathroom – 10 m² – with toilet;

* Second Living Room – 42 m² – stone walls, original Gironde tiles, panoramic view;

Extension:

* Large summer living room – 26 m² – with large bay windows opening onto the terrace with panoramic views;

* Office – 11 m²;

* Large master bedroom – 43 m² – with large bay windows opening onto the terrace with panoramic views;

* Dressing room - 4.5 m²;

* Bathroom - 11 m² - with bathtub, shower, toilet, panoramic view;

Hallway leading to:

* Toilet - with washbasin;

* Laundry room - 9 m²;

* Bedroom - 15 m² - with built-in wardrobes; en suite with

* Shower room - 5 m².

Upstairs:

18th-century section:

* Bedroom - 30 m²;

* Mezzanine - 18 m² - with sloping ceiling.

* Small storage shed attached to the house - 6 m²;
