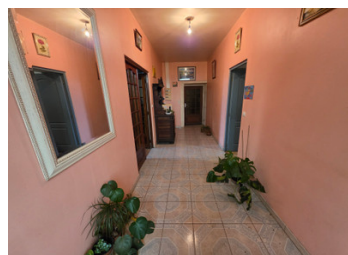


Agricultural property in Alloue with a 4-room house and 31.27 hectares of land, woodland, and outbuildings

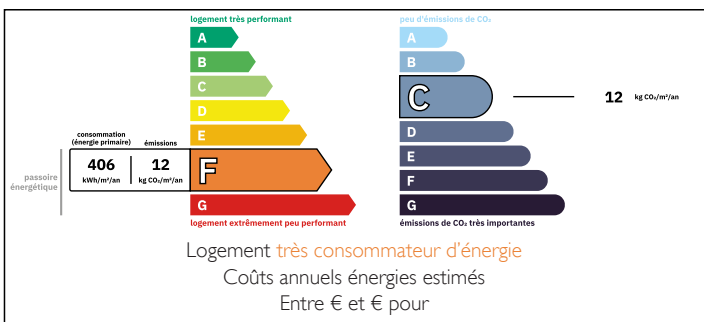
Located in a quiet and unspoilt rural setting, this agricultural property offers 31 hectares of strong, healthy, good-quality land, currently farmed organically.

The property includes a character farmhouse, formerly a small château, of approximately 125 sqm to renovate, with an attic suitable for conversion and a vaulted cellar, offering excellent potential after renovation.

Several agricultural buildings complete the property, including a barn, hangar, sheepfold and outbuildings, allowing for immediate use or future development of the project.

A rare opportunity, ideal for a sustainable farming project, a new agricultural venture, a career change, or a lifestyle project rooted in the land.

DESCRIPTION

Located in a peaceful and unspoilt rural setting, this agricultural property offers 31 hectares of high-quality farmland, including meadows, woodland, and outbuildings, currently operated under organic farming.

The main house, a former small château of approximately 125 m², is in need of full renovation and offers great potential for customization. The ground floor comprises a kitchen-dining room with a wood-burning stove, a living room, and a bathroom. Upstairs, there are three bedrooms and a landing in need of renovation. The 166 m² attic can also be converted to create additional living space. A vaulted stone cellar adds to the property's historic charm.

The estate is further enhanced by numerous agricultural outbuildings: barn, hangar, sheepfold, workshop, bread oven, former pigsty, and a separate building across the road, ideal for storage or livestock.

This property is a rare opportunity to establish a farming activity, develop an organic project, or simply enjoy an authentic lifestyle close to nature.

Heating: Wood stove and fireplace. Electric heating.
Sanitation: Septic tank (not compliant but existing).
Roof: No leaks. The house is in fairly good condition. The barns need some renovation.

Land: Very healthy soil, mostly flat with some gentle slopes. Includes some woodland plots.

Window simple glazed except 2 rooms in double glazed.
