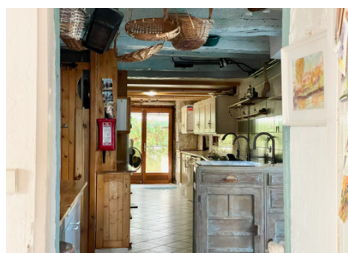


Time Stands Still at Le Vieux Couvent: A 18th-Century Masterpiece of Light and Stone

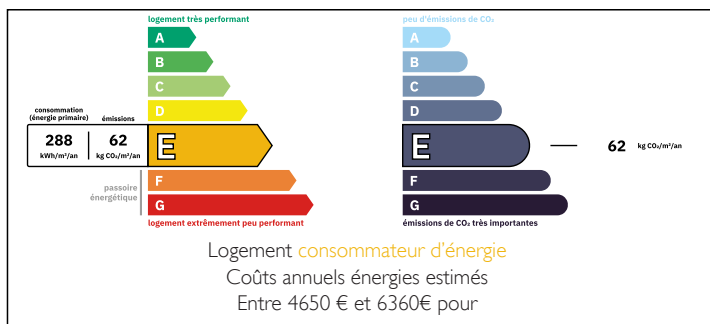
