The surroundings are simply magical, set within 15,362 m² (approximately 3.8 acres) of gardens and meadows, offering a peaceful and preserved natural environment.

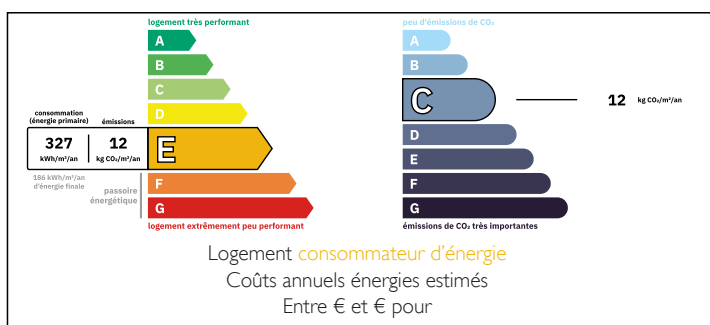

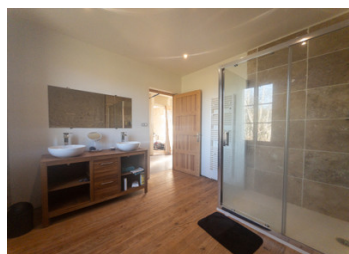

DESCRIPTION

Nestled in the Charente countryside, just minutes from a small town with all amenities and a SNCF train station, this unique property sits on the banks of a charming river.

The impressive watermill, approximately 168 m² and arranged over three levels, stands elegantly above the water. It was once dedicated to the production of walnut oil and walnut flour. The original wheels and other period features remain in place, offering authentic character and tremendous renovation potential to create exhibition spaces, a restaurant, holiday cottages, or guest rooms.

The main house, located opposite the mill, has been renovated and is ready to move into, with only a few finishing touches required.

The entrance hall of approximately 10 m², with its contemporary flooring, welcomes you into a bright and inviting home.

To the right, a 22 m² living room featuring a fireplace with a large wood-burning stove, exposed stone walls, and two large windows.

To the left, a beautiful modern kitchen, fully fitted and equipped.

To the rear, a practical utility/laundry room remains to be completed.

An original staircase leads to the first floor, where you will find three attractive bedrooms, each enjoying views over the countryside, as well as a recently installed shower room with walk-in shower, double vanity unit, and heated towel rail.

Recent works include: a light-enhancing aluminium front door, PVC double-glazed windows, updated electrical system, roof insulation redone, and a new drainage system.

The outbuildings are arranged around the courtyard. Attached to the mill is a large barn/stable of approximately 200...
