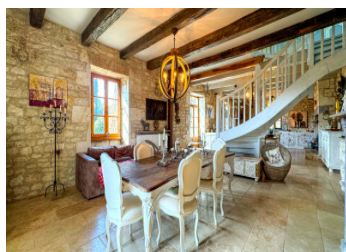

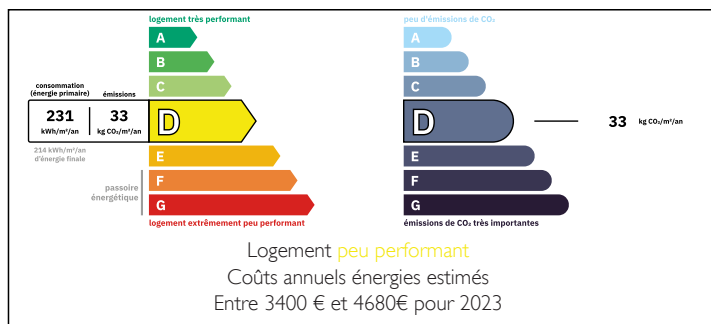

Inside the property, every space is designed for comfort and style,

GROUND FLOOR:

Kitchen/dining room (81 m²) with fully fitted kitchen, travertin flooring, fireplace with woodburners in both kitchen and dining room, doors opening to stunning raised deck/terrace (30 m²) with views

Pantry/utility area (14,7 m²)

WC (1,5 m²)

Salon (33 m²) with fireplace, French doors to balcony with views

Bedroom 1 (27,5 m²) exposed stone walls, beams, original wooden floorboards, fireplace, old stone sink, views (again!), en suite bathroom with wash basin, shower and WC
