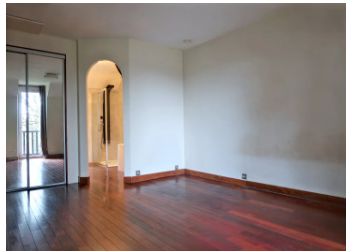


Charming Stone House with Open Countryside Views

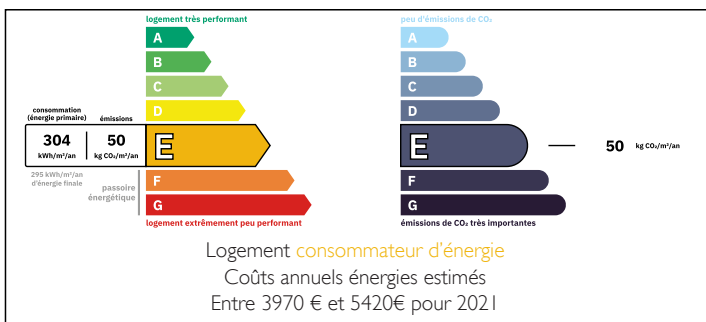
Upstairs are four bedrooms, including a master bedroom with en-suite bathroom, as well as an additional shower room and a separate WC.

The landscaped garden includes a pond/fishing basin, a garage with laundry/boiler room, a garden shed, and wood storage.

Heating is provided by an oil-fired boiler with a wood-burning insert, and the house benefits from double and triple glazing.

Spacious and bright, it features generous living areas and a warm atmosphere, making it ideal as a main residence or a countryside retreat.

On the ground floor, the house opens onto an entrance hall leading to a spacious double living room, a fully fitted and equipped independent kitchen, a separate WC, and a pleasant veranda of approximately 25 m² extending the living space and allowing you to enjoy natural light and the garden views throughout the year.

Upstairs, the sleeping area includes four bedrooms, including a master suite with private bathroom, as well as an additional shower room and a separate WC.

For comfort, the house benefits from oil-fired central heating, complemented by a wood-burning insert, and double and triple-glazed windows.

Outside, the bucolic landscaped grounds surround the house and invite relaxation. They feature a pond/fishing basin, a garage with utility/laundry and boiler room, as well as a garden shed and wood storage.

The property enjoys a quiet location close to several walking and hiking trails, while remaining conveniently close to local amenities:

- 7 minutes from Bujaleuf, with local shops and a leisure lake for swimming and fishing
- 15 minutes from Châteauneuf-la-Forêt and Eymoutiers
- Around 45 minutes from Limoges
