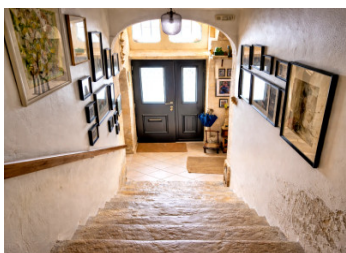


Renovated historic home with garden in central Sées, 5 bedrooms, charm and tranquility

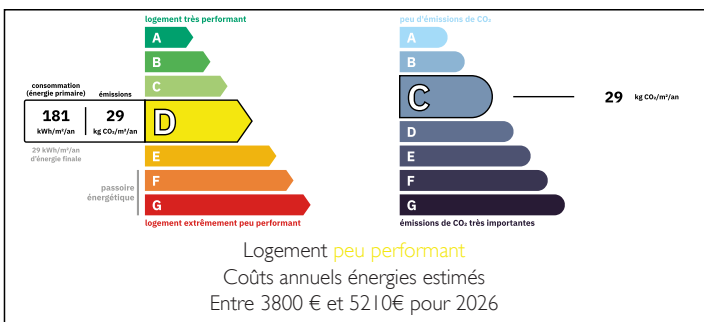

IN BRIEF

Character property in the historic heart of Sées, a former Franciscan residence dating from 1636, fully renovated to combine period charm with modern comfort. Located on a quiet street close to all amenities, the house offers 306 sqm of living space over three levels. It features bright, generous volumes: a large living room with fireplace, open kitchen, 5 bedrooms, a turret office/library, dressing room, and functional spaces. Outside, a landscaped east/south-facing garden with terrace and an entrance courtyard provide a peaceful setting. The property is in very good condition with recent upgrades, wood and gas heating, and good insulation. Ideally located near Alençon, Argentan, and Haras du Pin. A rare historic home, ideal for family living or investment.
