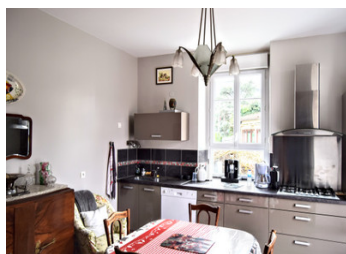

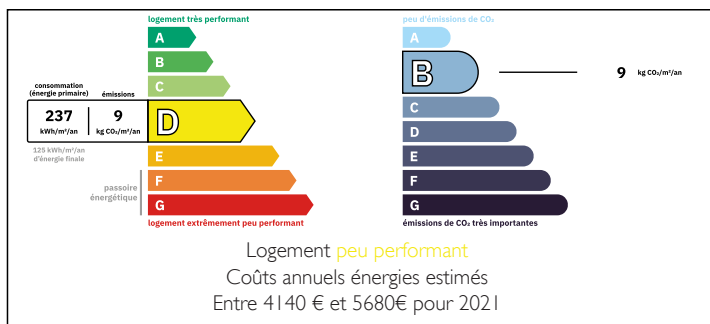

DESCRIPTION

The Main Residence

This impressive traditional home seamlessly blends historic charm with modern comfort. The heart of the house is the stylish, fully fitted contemporary kitchen, which features double doors opening directly onto the sun-drenched terrace—perfect for alfresco dining. The generous open-plan lounge and dining area also benefit from terrace access, creating a fluid indoor-outdoor living space ideal for entertaining.

The ground floor also offers a laundry room and a well-appointed bathroom with a shower-over-bath and WC.

A handsome wooden staircase leads to a wide, airy landing on the first floor. From here, double doors open onto a small balcony with localised views. This level comprises six well-proportioned double bedrooms, many retaining original period features. Two bedrooms have washbasins, and the floor is served by an additional modern shower room with WC.

One of the bedrooms is currently utilized as a secondary living room and provides staircase access to a large attic space. This area offers potential for conversion into a master suite, or further accommodation.

The Studio Apartments

Completely separate from the main house, the property includes two identical, self-contained studio apartments. Each unit features a kitchenette, a shower room with WC, and a good-sized living/sleeping area. These units are ideal for holiday lets, long-term rentals, or providing independent space for multi-generational living.

Gardens and Outbuildings

The exterior is a true highlight of the property. The south-west facing terrace overlooks a large, flat, manicured garden featuring a variety of mature trees
