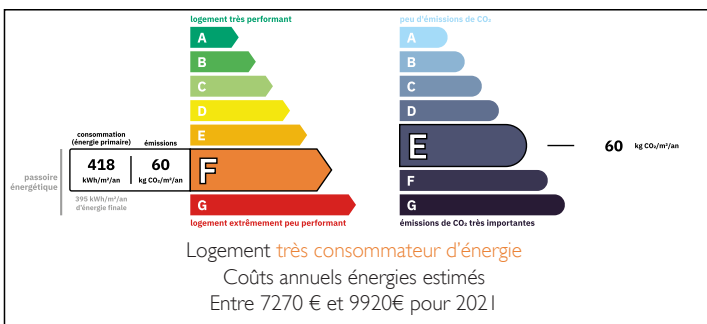

DESCRIPTION

To the front of the house is an enclosed private courtyard with iron gates. The main front door leads to an entrance hallway, big enough for a desk or small sofa, with feature fireplace. A window overlooks the rear garden. To the right, the large sitting room with mezzanine library or snug, has a pellet burner and windows on two aspects. All of the windows in the house are double-glazed.

This spacious room leads to a downstairs bedroom and a shower-room, which can also be accessed from outside.

To the left of the entrance hall, there is a welcoming dining room with beautiful granite fireplace and lots of original features including the old granite sink, and round windows. There is a door and window to both the front and rear of the property. Next on the ground floor is the kitchen, which leads to a pantry with sink and work units.

A closed staircase leads up to the first floor comprising 3 bedrooms, two shower rooms, and corridor. There is a hatch to the small loft.

Out the back door, there is another enclosed and private courtyard, and access to a separate boiler/utility room (oil heating, supplemented by the wood and pellet burners). There is a small stone outbuilding. Further round, there are external stairs leading to the annex. This offers additional independent space for visiting family or as a gite.
