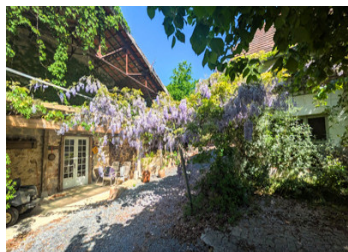


Charming Cottage with Studio, Pool, Barns & Land near Coussac-Bonneval.

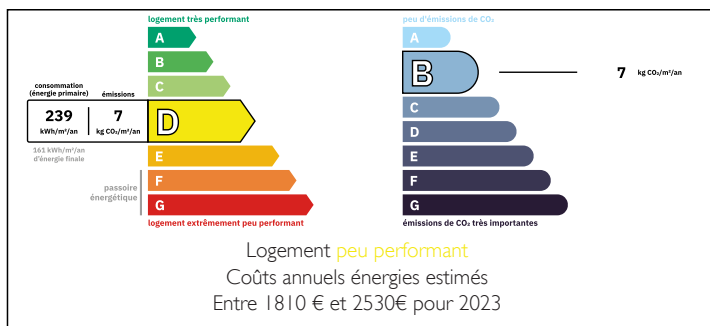

DESCRIPTION

The heart of the home is a spacious open-plan kitchen, living and dining area. The living/dining space (35m²) features beautiful wooden floors, exposed stone walls, and a traditional poêle de masse wood-burning stove, creating a warm and inviting atmosphere. The property benefits from double glazing throughout, enhancing comfort year-round.

The kitchen area (19.4m²) blends functionality with rustic charm, fitted with wooden units, a concrete worktop, electric oven, dishwasher, induction hob with integrated extractor fan.

On the ground floor there is also a utility room with WC, as well as a bathroom which requires some work.

Upstairs, the property offers two bedrooms: one 10.5m² bedroom and a spacious 23m² bedroom with exposed beams, wooden flooring, a WC, and a bright landing area with Velux windows.

Outside, a charming terrace enjoys open views over the land and surrounding woodland — a perfect place to relax or entertain. The property also benefits from a well and solar panels that generate income through electricity resale.

A major feature is the separate barn with a fully formed studio space, including a bedroom/living area, kitchen, and bathroom — ideal as a gîte, guest accommodation, or rental income, with further expansion potential.

The grounds extend to 14,163m² and include a salt-heated 10 x 5m swimming pool, numerous fruit trees, a traditional bread oven, wood store, hangar, barn, and piggery. This is a versatile property offering lifestyle living, smallholding potential, or tourism income opportunities.
