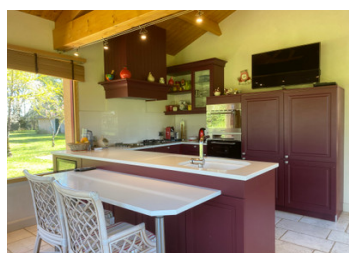
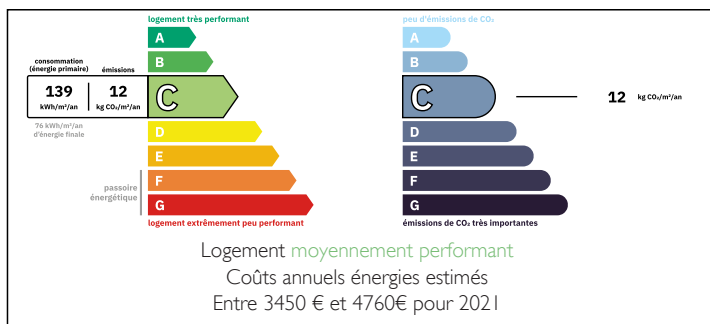

DESCRIPTION

This 18th-century property with stone walls and exposed beams is composed as follows:

GROUND FLOOR

- An entrance hall with stone flooring: 26.4 m² with authentic features (bull's-eye window, exposed beams, and original 18th-century flooring)
- A living room: 22 m²
- A bright dining room open to the kitchen: 28.13 m². Underfloor heating in the entrance area
- A kitchen created in 2009 with stunning views over the landscaped garden
- Bedroom 1: 20 m² with original wooden flooring and exposed beam ceiling (3 m high) and electric shutters
- Bedroom 2: electric shutters. Carpet (original parquet flooring underneath): 26 m² with a glass door opening onto the garden
- A bathroom with a large round bathtub, two sinks and a shower: 14.8 m². Door providing access to the garden with shutters
- A WC with hand basin: 1.5 m²

FIRST FLOOR

A staircase leads to a large 78 m² room with a billiard table and projector for home cinema use

- Bedroom 3: 18.6 m² with carpet and electric skylight
- Bedroom 4: 20.4 m² with carpet and electric skylight. A door leads to a small attic
- A shower room: 3.72 m²
- A WC: 1.24 m²
