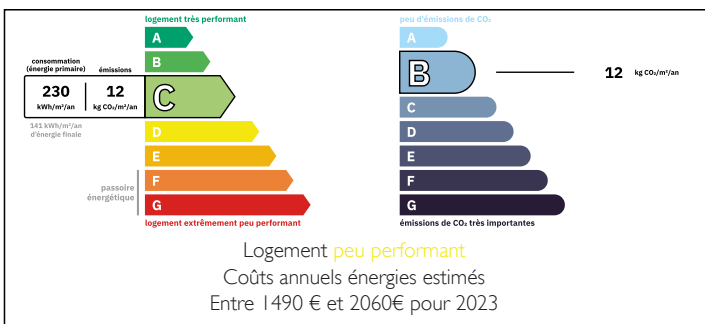

DESCRIPTION

Double gates into the garden, steps up to the front door. Enter into a hallway with cupboard to the right.

To the left, a door into the modern fitted kitchen where we find a run of floor and wall cabinets to the left, with sink, gas hob, oven. To the right, counter-style work surface with cabinets under.

This counter separates the kitchen from the light and airy living room with French doors onto the terrace and garden beyond. The wood-burning stove was installed in 2024. (total kitchen and living room, 31 m²)

From the hall, to the right of the front door a separate WC. Bathroom with bathtub and shower over, vanity unit with wash basin, plumbing for washing machine in one corner. Window to garden. Corridor to:

Bedroom 1 with window to garden (11.6 m²).

Bedroom 2 with window to garden (13.6 m²).

The floors are tiled throughout, making for easy cleaning and a robust surface - perfect when you come in from those long muddy walks through the forests and fields.

All of the windows are triple-glazed for excellent insulation, installed in 2023.

Gas-fired hot water heater.

The large garage will accommodate bigger vehicles. A staircase leads to a spacious mezzanine storage area. Internal door to the living room.

A crawl space under the house provides access to utilities for repairs and maintenance.

Outside, over 1500 m² of garden is mostly grass with a few trees dotted around. Fully fenced with mature hedges and metal gates, providing security for children and animals....
