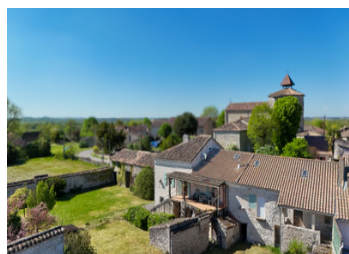

FIRST FLOOR:

Exterior terrace with views

Dining room (17,7 m²) with fireplace and woodburner

Kitchen/salon (51 m²) cathedral style, fireplace, fitted kitchen, original wooden flooring

Bedroom 1 (24,5 m²) with en suite bathroom (3,4 m²) with wash basin, shower, WC

Bathroom (6,11 m²) with wash basin, bath and WC (1 m²)

Bedroom 2 (8 m²) with small mezzanine (6,15 m²) with Velux window

GROUND FLOOR:

Spare room/bedroom 3 (21,6 m²)
