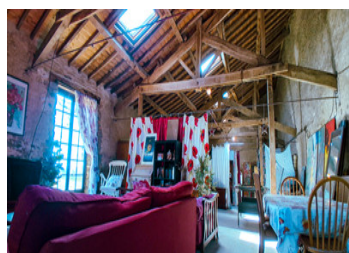
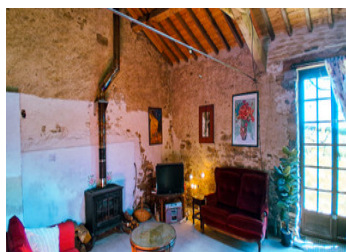

DESCRIPTION

The barn is arranged in three sections, offering excellent flexibility for conversion.

The left section has already been started with a concrete floor and initial plumbing and electrics in place. The central section has a high ceiling and is ideal for a large open plan living space with a mezzanine above. The right section provides further generous space suitable for additional accommodation, a studio or utility use depending on the design.

Outside, there is a terrace area and an above ground swimming pool with open countryside views. The setting offers a good sense of space with open land to the side and rear. Nearby, the village of La Chapelle aux Lys is known as a Star Village with very clear night skies. It is home to the Astrolys festival and a planetarium offering star and space experiences. The property is believed to date back over a century and reflects the agricultural history of the area. Built mainly in natural stone with some later brick additions, it has developed over time as part of a former farmstead. It is also understood to have links to the Second World War, adding further historical interest.
