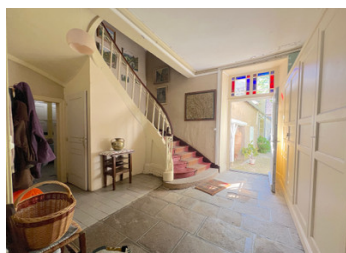

IN BRIEF

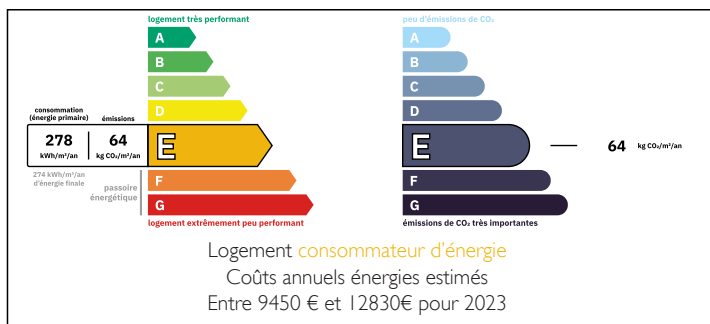
Situated in the small, rural town of Aigurande in the southern edge of the Indre department, the countryside is one of rolling hills, fields, small forests, and winding country roads.

Though modest in size, Aigurande carries a sense of history and rural identity, with seasonal events, small fairs, and local Farmers' market every Friday on the Market Square, surrounded by Lyme trees.

Aigurande has easy access to the larger, historic towns of Argenton-sur-Creuse, La Châtre and La Souterraine, and leisure and outdoor pursuits and fresh water swimming at the Lake at Éguzon and the area of the 3 Lakes.

DESCRIPTION

Dating from 1742, this large Bourgeoise property, has real history and beautiful, original features.

The front door, opens to a large entrance hall, vestibule, leading to three, large reception rooms, (24m2, 20m2, 26m2), a functional kitchen (26m2), prep-room (10m2), Bedroom (19m2) with en-suite shower room.

The beautiful, period staircase leads to a large landing, off which are 6 bedrooms (9m2, 10m2, 13m2, 29m2, 25m2 and one (27m2) with ensuite shower room.

Above, a large, attic space, with magnificent oak beams and rafters.

Outside, beautiful barns, convertible buildings, ideal to create habitable space, work space or cultural spaces. A well, cellar and central heating (oil) boiler room, all surrounding a very pretty, private courtyard garden. To the rear of the larger barn, another private garden, where ladies would take air and promenade.
