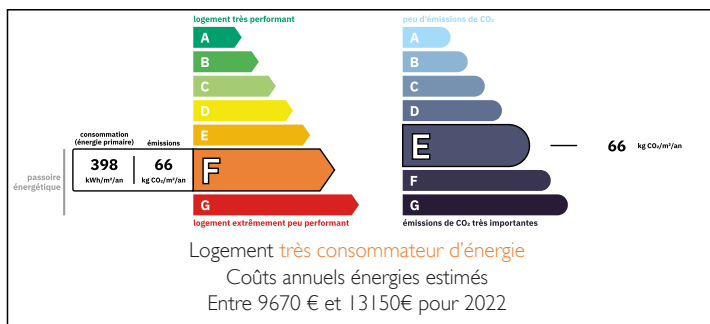
IN BRIEF

A very rare opportunity to acquire this Gothic château in the rolling countryside of Clécy, in the highly sought-after area of Swiss Normandy. Formerly operated as a hotel, the property offers seven bedrooms, each with its own en suite, as well as an additional outbuilding that could provide further independent accommodation separate from the château. Set within mature gardens rich in established trees and shrubs, the property presents exceptional potential—whether for a bed and breakfast venture, the hosting of events and weddings, or as a spacious family home, or simply a welcoming retreat with ample space for family and friends.

Ideally located within easy reach of the ferry port of Ouistreham, Caen, and the D-Day landing beaches along the north coast, this property enjoys a highly desirable setting.

DESCRIPTION

Approached through gates and a sweeping driveway that winds gracefully through the gardens, the château reveals itself with a sense of quiet grandeur. The front door opens into an inviting entrance hall, from which the principal reception room unfolds to the left, enjoying views over the sunken garden at the front of the property. The ground floor also features a warm and characterful kitchen with a wood-burning fire, a scullery/pantry, a comfortable sitting room, a library, a smaller office or reception room, and a light-filled conservatory.

The first floor comprises four beautifully appointed bedrooms, each with its own en suite, two of which benefit from private balconies, alongside an elegant sitting room providing an additional space for relaxation. The second floor offers three further bedrooms, all again with their own en suite facilities, continuing the sense of comfort and refinement throughout.

Outside, the former coach house is currently utilised as storage and workshop space, complemented by a separate boiler room housing the central heating system. In addition, two cottages—partially renovated—offer excellent potential for further accommodation, whether for guests, rental income, or independent living.
