A castle of manageable size, offering beautiful light and spacious living areas, overlooking the river with spacious terraces and a lovely park.

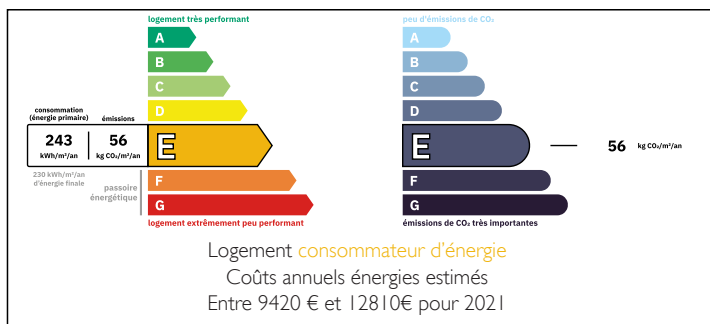

A perfect property for history buffs and for hosting...

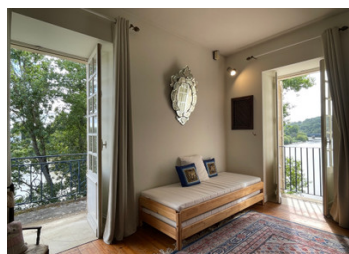

DESCRIPTION

The CHATEAU is raised above a basement comprising a garage, a wine cellar, and a large workshop/storage area. A majestic stone staircase leads to the entrance hall and the terraces overlooking the Dordogne River, offering an ultimate in tranquility!

It offers a total living area of 370 m², including:

On the ground floor:

Gironde tiles on the floor.

- * Entrance hall - 22 m² - with cloakroom and WC, a wide stone staircase providing access to the wine cellar and basement, as well as the first and second floors;

- * Laundry room - 11 m²;

- * Living room - 41 m² - with a monumental fireplace, two French doors opening onto the terrace;

- * Bar/reception room - 27 m² - with attractive built-in cupboards, French doors opening onto the terrace;

- * Office - 15 m² - with French doors opening onto the terrace;

- * Dining room - 38 m² - with a monumental fireplace, original water feature, and built-in cupboard with original doors; French doors opening onto the terrace;

- * Kitchen - 34 m² - fully equipped, with a fireplace and other original features such as an oven and sink; French doors opening onto the terrace.
