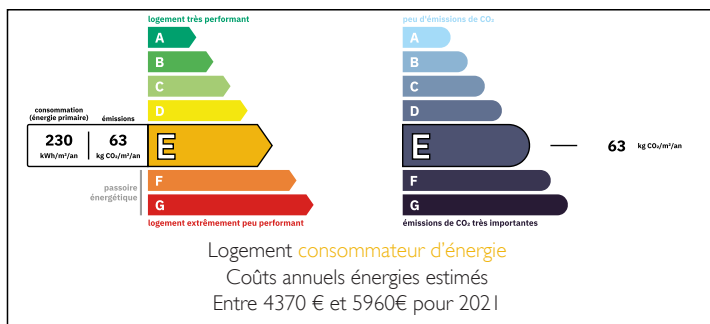

Offering approximately 316m² of habitable space, the property retains many original features while benefiting from modern amenities such as double-glazed windows and fibre optic internet, making it ideal as either a main residence or a holiday home.

Ground floor:

The entrance hall leads into a spacious and welcoming living room with an open fireplace, perfect for cosy evenings with family and friends. The kitchen is both practical and generous in size, ideal for entertaining. A large office of approximately 23m² could also serve as a ground-floor bedroom if required. A separate WC completes this level.

First floor:

A bright landing leads to five comfortable bedrooms offering flexible accommodation for family and guests. One of the bedrooms benefits from its own en-suite bathroom, while a second bathroom and separate WC serve the remaining rooms.

Exterior:

Set within approximately 688m² of private gardens, the outdoor space is beautifully landscaped with mature trees, colourful plants and a variety of aromatic herbs. The garden also features several fruit trees including fig, apple and quince trees, creating a peaceful and authentic Mediterranean atmosphere.
