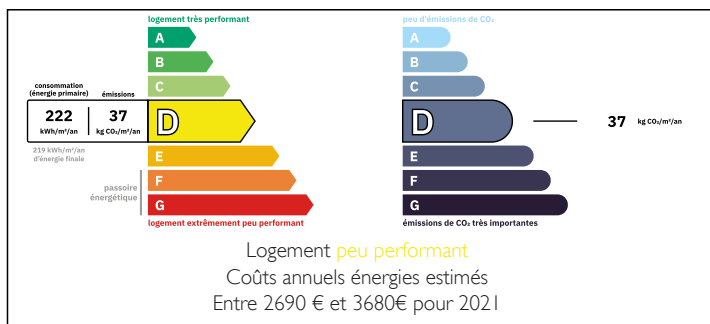

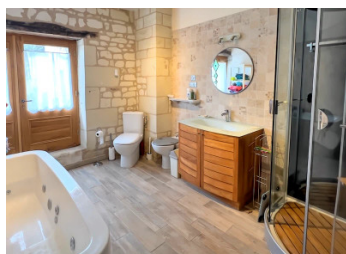

The layout is both unique and highly adaptable. On one side of the ground floor, you'll find a cosy living area with a log burner, a kitchen corner, and WC, creating a warm and inviting everyday space. Stairs lead from here to two bedrooms and a bathroom on the first floor.

On the other side of a charming covered terrace, and with its own independent access, is a second ground-floor living area comprising a kitchen/dining room, a bedroom, and a bathroom. An ideal place for guests, extended family, or as a self-contained gîte.

Linking these two parts of the house is a truly impressive first-floor living space of approximately 55m², featuring a loft-style design with high ceilings and wood flooring. This bright and airy room not only provides a stunning central living area but also allows the property to function either as one spacious home or as two independent spaces.
