A semi-detached town house comprising:

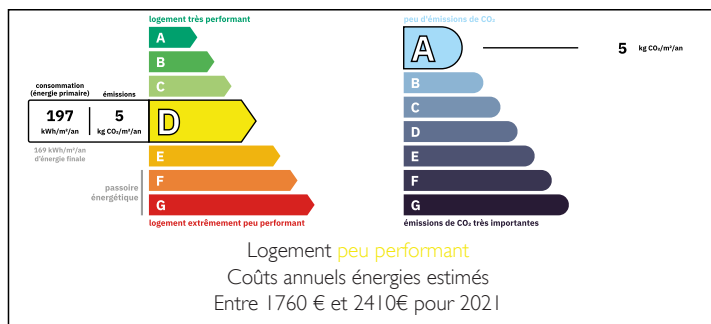
On the ground floor: a living room, an open-plan kitchen/living area with a wood pellet stove, a shower room, a separate WC, and a door leading to a workshop.

DESCRIPTION

This charming property offers a practical and welcoming layout, perfectly suited to comfortable everyday living.

On the ground floor, the house opens into a bright and inviting living room, leading to an open-plan kitchen and dining area, complete with a wood pellet stove that adds both warmth and a cosy focal point. This level also includes a shower room and a separate WC. A door from the main living space provides direct access to an adjoining workshop, offering excellent potential for hobbies, DIY projects, or conversion into a utility room. On the opposite side of the house, there is additional storage space, ideal for garden furniture and outdoor equipment.

A generous central staircase leads to the first floor, where a spacious bedroom currently spans the full width of the house. As renovation is ongoing, this area offers flexible potential and could easily be reconfigured to create two or even three bedrooms, depending on requirements.

Outside, the property boasts a well-proportioned garden, perfect for relaxing or entertaining, while enjoying open, uninterrupted views over the surrounding countryside.
