IN BRIEF

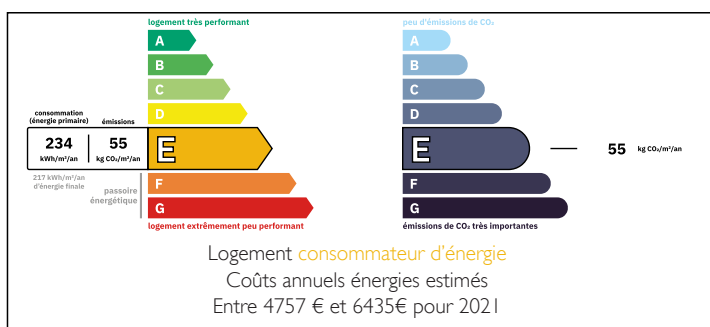

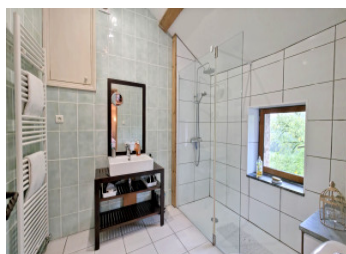
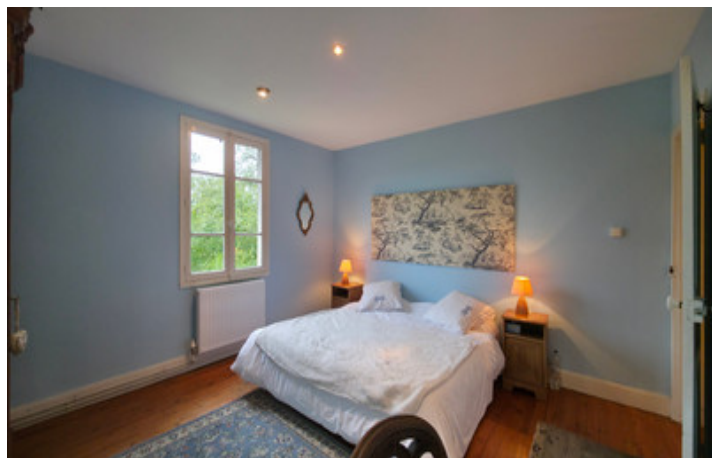

DESCRIPTION

A house with an attached barn covered in tiles, comprising:

> On the ground floor: an entrance hall, to the right a door to the basement, a few steps up to a modern bathroom with a bathtub, shower, sink, and toilet, and a large living room/salon with an open fireplace. To the left of the entrance hall, a large open-plan living area combining a kitchen, dining room, and lounge.

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> on the first floor: accessed from the living area, a landing and a large family bedroom with en-suite bathroom and toilet, two further bedrooms, and a third bathroom with a sink, shower, and toilet.

> Accessed from the living area, a large basement comprising laundry and utility room housing the electric hot water tank and gas boiler. Accessed from outside the house, another large basement with workshop and garden storage.

> Land with trees bearing walnut, hazelnut and fig, a well, a small pigsty, lavoire and outdoor four à pain.
