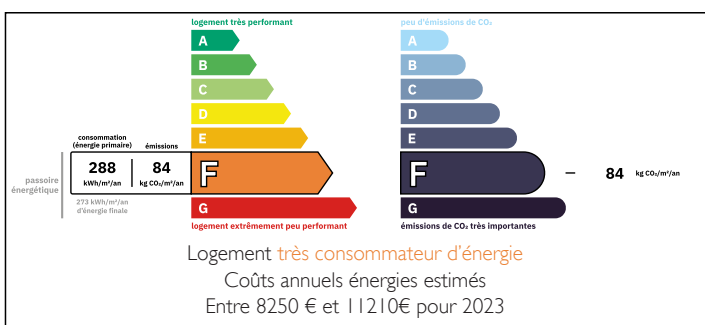

DESCRIPTION
