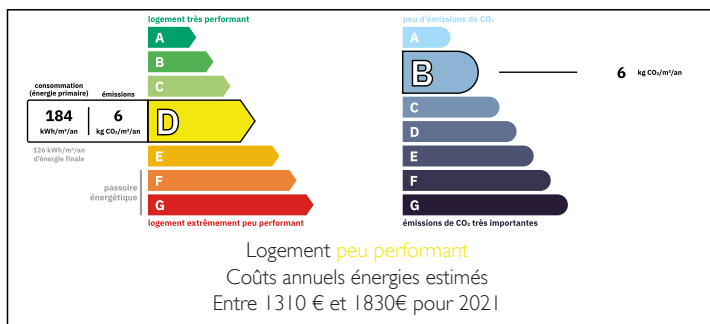

Outside, a private swimming pool, mature garden of 1560m2, and sunny terraces provide the perfect setting for long summer days and relaxed evenings overlooking the vines.

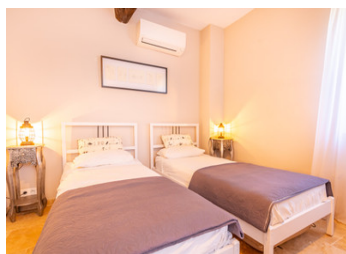

Located in the heart of the charming canal village of Paraza in the sought-after Minervois wine region, this beautifully presented stone house offers an ideal blend of character, comfort, and easy Mediterranean living.

The main house features a spacious and elegant entrance hall with exposed beams, setting the tone for the rest of the property. A recently remodelled kitchen opens directly onto the west-facing terrace, perfect for outdoor dining and enjoying the warm evening light. The living room and dining area are bathed in natural light, enhanced by a striking arched window that frames open vineyard views, with direct access to a south-facing terrace — creating a seamless indoor-outdoor lifestyle.

Also on the ground floor, there is a utility room and separate WC, adding practicality for everyday living.

The property offers three bedrooms, each with its own private en-suite bathroom, including one conveniently located on the ground floor. The two additional bedrooms each benefit from their own independent stairway access, offering excellent privacy for guests and making the layout particularly well suited for a chambre d'hôtes or rental activity.

The exterior spaces are designed to fully enjoy the South of France climate, with a beautifully maintained and mature garden of approximately 1,560 m². At the heart of the garden is a swimming pool (12m x 6m) surrounded by terraces, ideal for relaxing or entertaining.
