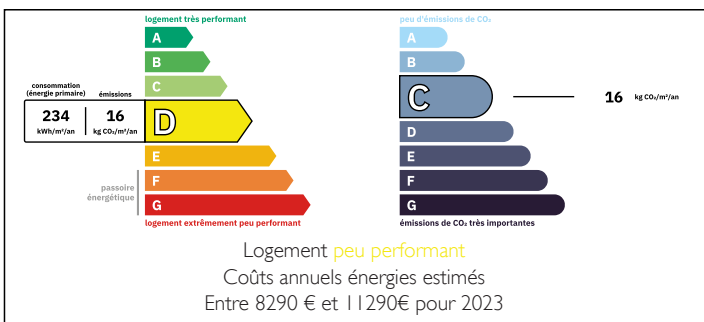

The gardens are predominantly flat and enjoy excellent sunshine throughout the day, making them ideal for outdoor dining, relaxing by the pool or enjoying the slower rhythm of southwest France.

The main residence immediately charms with its authentic character and warm atmosphere.
