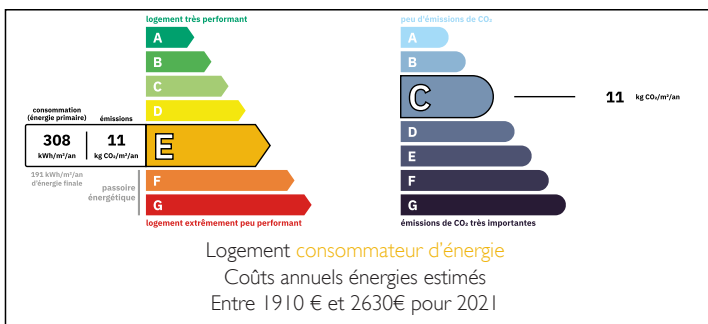
## IN BRIEF

## DESCRIPTION

Let's begin our tour in the heart of this little hamlet with its four houses – you're sure to fall in love with it!

Its rustic charm, blending stone and wood, is evident throughout.

We step inside to discover the 27m<sup>2</sup> living area, which is pleasant and practical with its kitchenette, efficient wood-burning stove and dining area.

Next, a wooden staircase leads us upstairs to the sleeping area, comprising a bedroom with a view of the lush green mountains opposite, a study and a shower room with WC.

You will also appreciate the converted basement with a kitchen, pantry and toilet; this space opens onto a small terrace, also accessible from outside, the perfect spot for enjoying good times with friends and family!

The house is fitted with double glazing and insulation; heating is provided by NFC, NF\*\* and NF\*\*\*-certified electric convector heaters, supplemented by a recent wood-burning stove (logs) with the 'Flamme Verte' label and a room-by-room programmer (individual system).

Outside, various plots of land not adjoining the property but in the immediate vicinity will allow you to create your own vegetable garden and grow your own firewood to fuel the stove.
