IN BRIEF

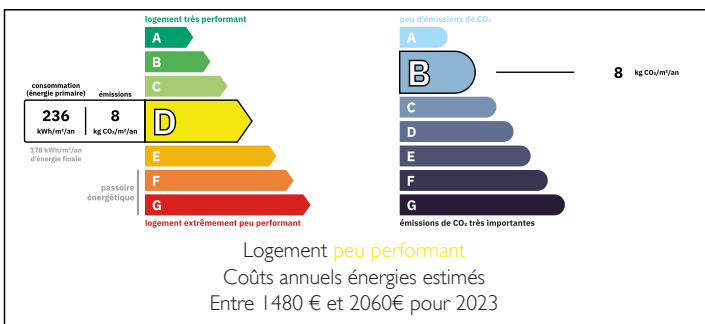
Located on a cul-de-sac in a small, very quiet hamlet near the Dordogne, this former barn converted by an architect in the 1990s. The house was designed to offer distinct spaces, the exterior flows seamlessly into the interior living areas, and the terraces serve as true additional living spaces.

Arranged in a star-shaped layout across several levels, the entryway leads to the dining room/kitchen and terrace two steps down, to a large double living room two steps up, and to a mezzanine bedroom a bit higher still. The living room can easily be partitioned off to create an additional bedroom.

Connected via the porch, the cottage features a living area with a small kitchenette, and upstairs, a bedroom with a shower room.

The entire property is charming, built with quality and taste using beautiful materials; the garden is full

DESCRIPTION

Charming stone house featuring on the ground floor an entryway with closets and a laundry room, a bathroom with toilet; a few steps down: a kitchen open to the dining room with French doors leading to the terrace; on the upper half-floor, a living room with a wood-burning stove; in the attic, a mezzanine bedroom. On the ground floor: a cellar, a garage with a small office space

Independent Cottage

Ideal for guests or family, this small independent cottage (connected through the porch) has been fitted with a kitchenette area and living room with fireplace, plus an attic bedroom with shower room and WC.

This former barn was converted in the 1990s with great care and attention to detail; the cottage was created within an old house dating back to 1797.
