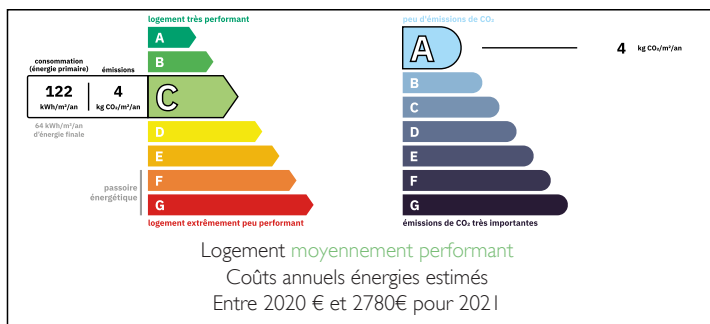

DESCRIPTION

Set behind large wooden gates in the heart of the Pyrenean village of Ardiège, this beautiful hidden gem immediately surprises and delights.

From the village lane, very little prepares you for what lies beyond: a substantial character home dating from around 1875, complete with swimming pool, attached barn, hayloft, enclosed gardens including a flat parcel of land (constructible subject to planning permission).

Private, peaceful with character, a home original character and genuine potential with modern improvements including double glazing throughout and an economical Hitachi air/water heat pump heating system.

The property combines the warmth and charm of a traditional Pyrenean home with exciting possibilities for future projects, a perfect family residence with income potential or simply a wonderful retreat to share with friends and family.

A large porte cochère opens onto a private driveway with parking for three to four vehicles. The house itself immediately catches the eye with its attractive façade and exposed timber framing, hinting at the character waiting inside.

ENTRANCE

The spacious entrance, with tiled flooring features an original wooden staircase with its lovely balustrade leading to the upper floors.

A second entrance to the property leads into the kitchen with a separate WC.
