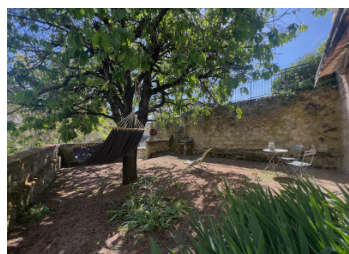


Beautiful Historic Townhouse with Renovated Loft and Garden in the Heart of Chinon

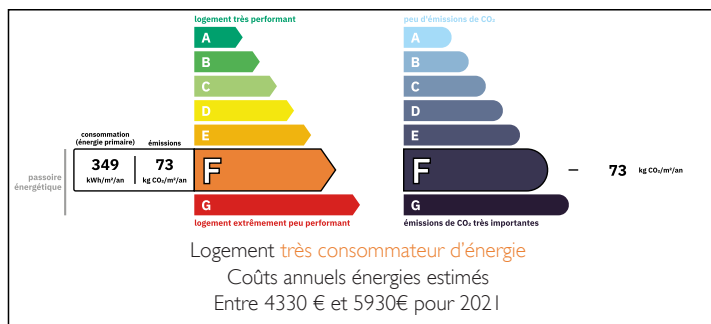

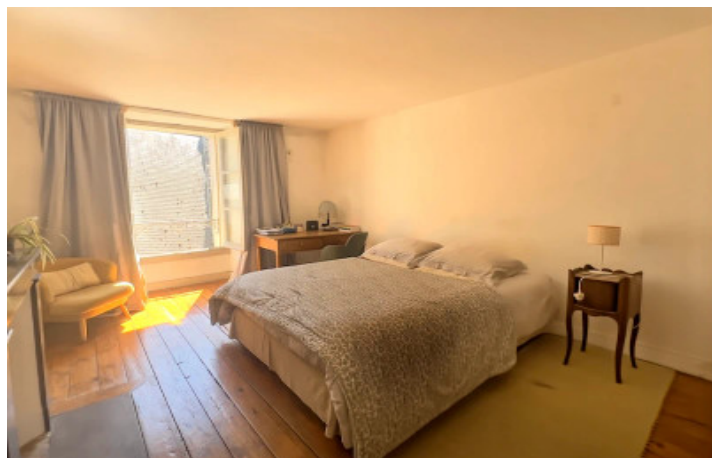

DESCRIPTION

Set on a quiet street in the historic centre of Chinon, this beautiful and characterful stone townhouse presents an exciting opportunity to create a truly exceptional home in one of the Loire Valley's most sought-after medieval towns.

The current owners have already completed the renovation of the top floor, transforming the attic into a stunning loft-style living space filled with light and charm. This beautifully finished area offers an open-plan kitchen, dining and sitting room, together with a bedroom and bathroom, creating a comfortable and stylish living space ready to enjoy immediately while the remainder of the property is restored.

Arranged over three spacious floors, the house retains an abundance of original character, including high ceilings, elegant proportions, original tiled floors, beautiful wooden flooring and a magnificent wooden staircase connecting the levels. The ground floor opens into a grand entrance hall with original tiles, leading to a lovely reception room with gorgeous doors opening directly onto the garden. A kitchen with existing plumbing offers further renovation potential.

On the first floor are three generous bedrooms, one with a shower, one with a sink, together with a bathroom and an additional living room, all benefiting from wonderful natural light and the timeless charm of this historic property.

Outside, the house enjoys a delightful private garden with terrace, peaceful and not overlooked, providing a rare sense of tranquillity in the centre of town. There is also an outbuilding offering additional storage or development potential, as well as separate access from...
