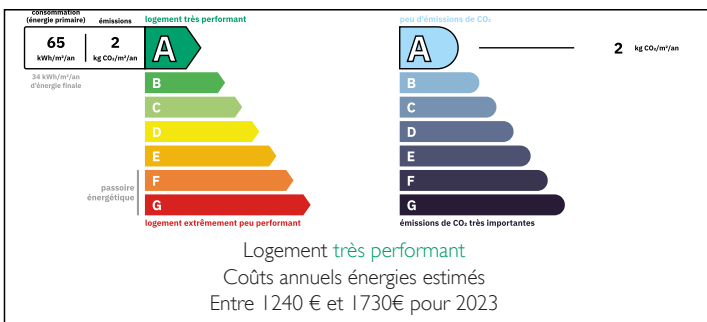
Just a short walk from the historic center, this magnificent stone mansion in the Périgord Noir region, dating from 1750, has been fully renovated to the highest standards.
