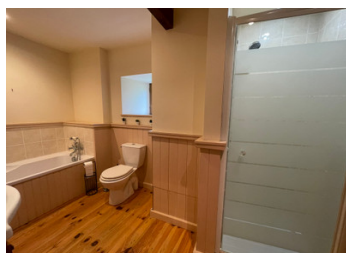


Pretty 4 bedroom stone cottage in Central Brittany

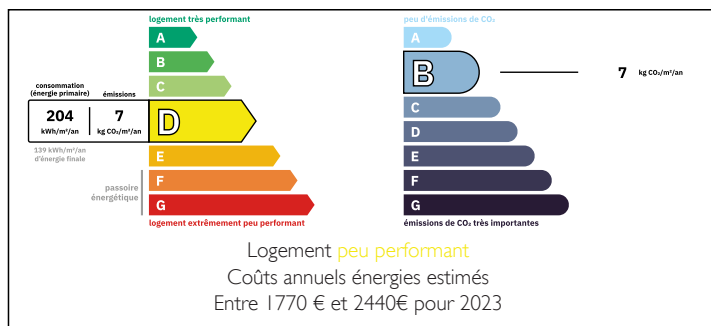

Such a pretty stone, semi detached cottage in a peaceful hamlet with stunning walks across the countryside straight from your front door! Located just outside Langast and a short drive from Plessala which has a bar, bakery, supermarket, garden centre and hairdressers.

The nearest larger town is Plouguenast-Langast where there is a variety of shops, larger supermarkets and a number of bars and restaurants. It's central location means that you are an hours drive to the port of St Malo, Rennes, Dinard or Dinan. The rugged North Brittany beaches are an hours drive or you could explore the southern coast at Vannes which is the same distance.

DESCRIPTION

The small path leads to a pretty, yet new, double glazed front door. On the ground floor there is an open plan L shaped room with the lounge plus wood burner, dining area and the kitchen. This area is tiled and there is a door off the kitchen leading to the garden. The property is full of character with exposed stone walls and tiled flooring.

On the first floor there are two bedrooms and a bathroom with bath, shower cubicle, sink, WC and heated towel rail. On this floor there is a large under stair cupboard for storage. On the second floor there are a further two bedrooms plus a shower room with a shower, WC, sink and heated towel rail.

The bedrooms and hallway all have the original wooden floors which are a lovely feature for the property. There is also plenty of storage, three of the bedrooms have fitted cupboards.

The house is fitted with a Linky metre and there are electric radiators. There is currently a fosse (septic tank) but the hamlet is due to be put onto mains drainage in the future and we have the paperwork to show the process is underway. There is a front and rear garden with patio area plus parking at the side of the property.
