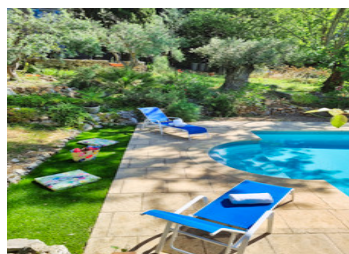


19th-century bastide – between Provence and the French Riviera, 10 rooms, swimming pool set on 4 600 m

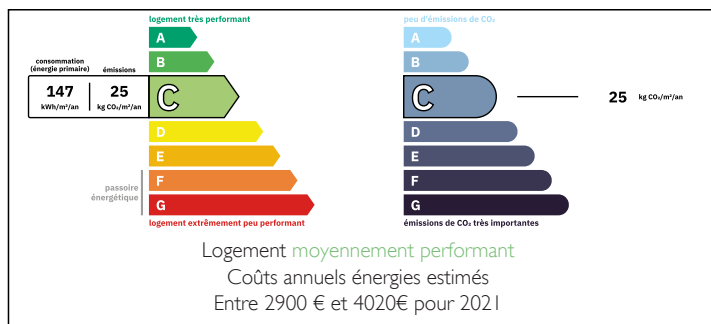
IN BRIEF

In a haven of softness, in Lorgues, close to the French Riviera, lies a truly exceptional property, rich in history, awaiting new owners to write the next chapter of its story.

Built on solid and historic foundations, this elegant 19th-century character residence (1840) offers approximately 280 m² of living space across 10 rooms. It features six welcoming bedrooms, several warm and inviting living areas, and enchanting outdoor spaces that inspire serenity.

The property beautifully blends old-world charm—terracotta tiles, exposed beams, and natural stone—with modern comfort, including a heat pump, solar panels, a swimming pool, a pigeonier, and a large garage. It is set on approximately 4,600 m² of landscaped grounds planted with centuries-old olive trees.

DESCRIPTION

In the heart of unspoiled Provence, close to the beauty and glamour of the French Riviera, this 19th-century bastide in Lorgues seems suspended between sky and earth, like a living memory of Mediterranean serenity. Built in 1840, it embodies a rare elegance, where every stone tells a story and each passing season gently reveals a new layer of its timeless charm.

Behind its historic façades and softly weathered shutters, the property unfolds nearly 287 m² of harmonious living space, nestled within approximately 4,600 m² of beautifully landscaped grounds.

Designed as a true family home, it combines the soul of traditional Provençal architecture with the discreet comfort of a thoughtful renovation. Original terracotta floors, exposed beams, and abundant natural light create a warm and inviting atmosphere where time seems to slow down.

The ground floor opens onto a spacious living area where the kitchen flows naturally into the reception space, all oriented towards the terraces and gardens beyond. Large openings blur the boundary between indoors and outdoors, inviting the surrounding landscape into everyday life. A semi-subterranean vaulted wine cellar, accessed from the utility room, adds a unique touch of authenticity and character.

A half level above, an elegant library lounge with its original fireplace provides a peaceful retreat for quiet evenings and intimate gatherings. The upper floors offer several generous bedrooms, an inspiring office, and a large versatile room that could serve as a games room, artist's studio, gym, or relaxation space, complemented by shower rooms and a family...
