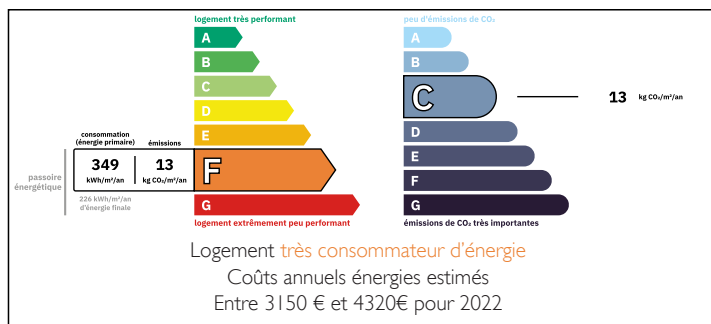

DESCRIPTION

You enter the home directly into the dining room (19m²) featuring a fireplace with an insert. To the right, the living room (22m²) offers front-facing windows. From the living room, a shower room (3m²) has a shower, sink and WC. A door leads to a utility space (3m²) which housing the washing machine which continues through to the attached garage (21m²). A few steps down from the dining room, is the fitted kitchen (10m²) overlooking the garden.

Taking the staircase from the dining room to the first floor, the large landing (19m²). Up a couple of steps is a bedroom (17m²) with ensuite shower room (7m²) with shower, sink & WC and dressing room (4m²).

Stairs continue to the second floor where there is a bedroom (11.5m²) with WC (2m²).

From the kitchen, a door leads to steps descending into the garden which is in the town moat. Beneath the kitchen is a cellar, perfect for storing garden tools which is accessed from the garden. The garden is mainly laid to lawn with a terrace, ideal for outside dining. A door in the provides stair access back into the garage – practical for removing garden waste.

The historic walled town of Richelieu has all the amenities you require including bakers, pharmacy, supermarket, cinema, banks, restaurants and bars and a weekly market on a Friday. The town has regular brocantes, antique fairs and art exhibitions throughout the year as well as other bi-annual festivals. The perfect location...

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
