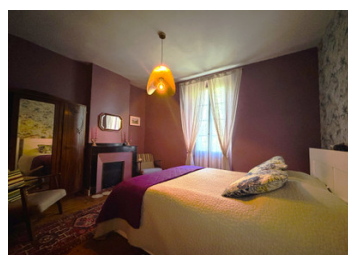
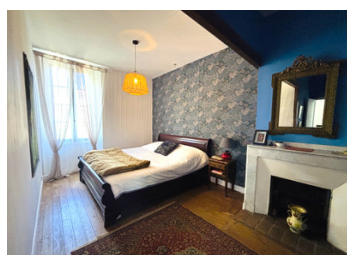
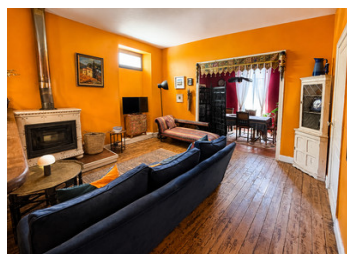


Delightful, spacious merchant's house in central Carcassonne. Elegant proportions, 5 bedrooms, private garden

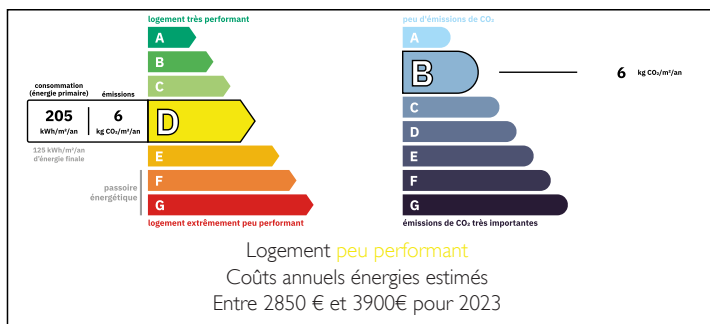

On the first floor is a large bathroom and 5 double bedrooms, with a separate WC and again space to create a shower room.

Set in the highly desirable Quartier Pasteur, this elegant period home offers the rare combination of peace and privacy while being just a short stroll from the vibrant heart of Carcassonne, with its cafés, restaurants and cultural attractions. Sympathetically renovated, the property successfully blends original architectural charm with the comfort and convenience of modern living.

The welcoming entrance hall, complete with vestibule, provides access to the principal reception rooms and opens through to the rear garden. To the right, the ground floor living space has been thoughtfully opened up to create a spacious and inviting open-plan living, dining and kitchen area of approximately 42m². Filled with natural light from windows to both front and rear, this stylish room retains beautiful original wooden and tiled flooring and is centred around an impressive antique ceramic stove, creating warmth and character. The kitchen, partially separated by a low wall, is well equipped with a high-quality range cooker and traditional double enamel sink, with pleasant views over the garden.

To the left of the hallway is a second reception room of 15m², ideal as a sitting room, office or professional consultation space for those wishing to work from home. Beyond this lies the attractive curved wooden staircase leading to the upper floors, along with a convenient ground-floor WC.

At the rear of the house, a further 15m² study offers excellent flexibility and could easily serve as a ground-floor bedroom. Adjacent to this room is a walk-in cupboard with existing plumbing,...
