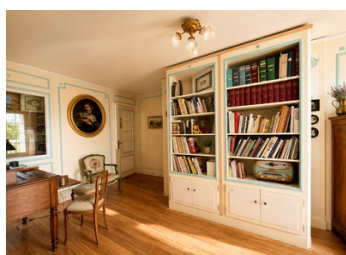
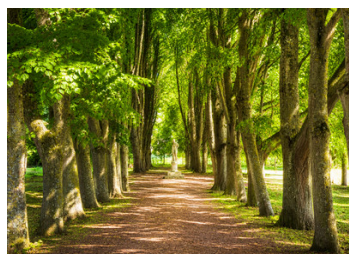

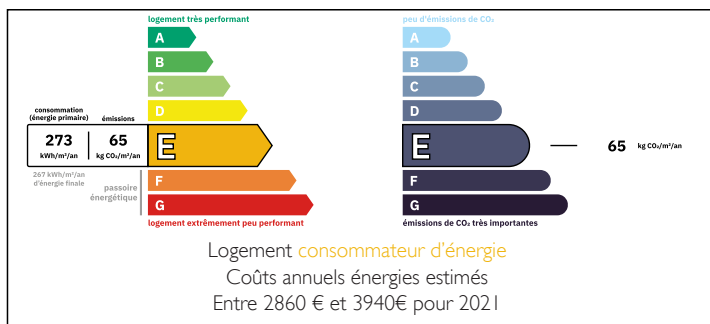

DESCRIPTION

CHARACTER PROPERTY ON THE OUTSKIRTS OF FALAISE – 3.52 HECTARES

Just a few minutes from Falaise, the historic medieval town renowned as the birthplace of William the Conqueror, this property is a true hidden sanctuary. Completely screened from the road by mature hedges, nothing hints at what lies beyond. Once through the impressive entrance gates, a magnificent cross-shaped driveway lined with centuries-old lime trees leads towards the buildings, creating an impressive first impression.

Set within 3.52 hectares (8.7 acres) of beautifully landscaped grounds, this exceptional property perfectly combines the charm of the Normandy countryside, the comfort of recent renovations and equestrian facilities.

The main house, extending to approximately 180 m² (1,937 sq ft), has undergone extensive recent improvements, particularly throughout the ground floor. High-quality finishes include beautiful travertine flooring, generous living spaces, abundant natural light and carefully selected materials.

The ground floor comprises:

- a spacious 23 m² fully fitted and equipped kitchen;
- an elegant 44 m² reception room flooded with natural light;
- a comfortable 18 m² bedroom with its own en-suite shower room, allowing for convenient single-level living;
- a large utility/laundry room and a partial basement.

Upstairs, the property retains all the charm of a traditional country residence, with period mouldings and a warm, inviting atmosphere. It offers:

- a delightful 15 m² library;
- a 16 m² study;
- two bedrooms measuring 17 m² and 10 m²;
- a family bathroom.
